## Care and Maintenance

- · Cleaning is recommended after each use.
- · For daily cleaning it is recommended to use a soft or microfiber sponge and hot water.
- To clean stubborn stains, we recommend using neutral pH soap and soft or microfibre sponges, then rinsing everything with plenty of hot water so as not to leave any residue.
- · Do not place hot objects on it.
- Do not use adhesive materials or glues on it.
- · Do not use aggressive detergents, bleaches, thinners, corrosive substances, chemicals, industrial solvents, thinners and similars.
- Do not use abrasive or metal sponges and do not engrave or abrade the treated surface.
